An important reminder

We follow the Lee County school district dress code

If your child does not follow the dress code, he or she will be sent home. It will be the parents/guardians responsibility to make arrangements on getting them home.

The purpose of the dress code is to encourage students to focus on the learning process without the distractions of unsuitable dress and grooming, as well as developing good habits that will lead to “dressing for success” in college and career. Students shall maintain a clean, orderly appearance at all times.

Clothes should be adequate in both length and coverage to be considered appropriate for school. Skirts are to be at two inches above the knee and shorts are to be mid thigh.

Transparent or see-through tops, bare midriff, strapless, or tops and outfits that provide minimum coverage or are of a suggestive nature are prohibited. **NO CROP TOPS!!**

Pants shall be worn fastened at the waist. It is unacceptable for undergarments to be exposed.

Apparel, emblems, or symbols that promote the use of alcohol, drugs, tobacco, violence or any other illegal activity are prohibited.

Apparel or symbols which may be gang-related may not be displayed on a student's person.
